ARTICLE XI ELECTIONS

- 1-11.1 All city elections shall be conducted in the manner prescribed by the Code of Iowa.
- 1-11.2 Nominations for candidates for elective city offices may be made by petition and their names shall be placed on the ballot for the city election in accordance with the procedure outlined in Chapter 45 and related provisions of the Code of Iowa. (Ordinance No. 1983-1, passed September 12, 1983.)
- 1-11.3 Every elected official shall be a qualified voter of the city.
- 1-11.4 Candidates in a regular city election who receive the greatest number of votes for each office on the ballot are elected, to the extent necessary to fill the positions open, as provided in Section 376.8(3) of the Code of Iowa.
- 1-11.5 Terms of elected city officials shall begin and end at noon on the first day of January which is not a Sunday or legal holiday following a regular city election.
- 1-11.6 A vacancy in an elective city office during a term of office shall be filled in accordance with Section 1-2.8 of the Municipal Code of the City of Salem.
